## The managers point of view

Firstly let me welcome the players officials and spectators of Cottenham United to Crofters for this afternoons Eastern Region Division One West game. We hope you enjoy your short stay with us and that you have a safe journey home afterwards.

## Women's FA Cup 2nd Qualifying Round

### Sawbridgeworth Town v Whitehawk 2—4

Sawbow started quickly and was applying early pressure on the Hawks defence but Whitehawk responded by putting their own pressure on Debbie Williams and on 2 minutes Hawks Kate Baker hit over the bar from 12 yards. 2 minutes later it was Baker again and she pulled the ball in from the left flank and shot wide. After this early pressure the game settled a little and Sawbo then got the break with a corner on 9 minutes . Jackie Stott floated the ball into the box and after a few attempts Gaynor Fisher had the last kick to put the ball over the line for Sawbow to go one up. It was some 10 minutes later that Whitehawk drew level when Cath Tomlin struck a curling shot from the left of the box over Williams and into the goal. This goal lifted Whitehawk who were now a little quicker to every ball but Sawbow were not to be denied as they kept to their task . On 28 minutes a foul conceded by Whitehawk on the left edge of the box saw Jackie Stott float the ball high into the goal mouth where Debbie Biggins in the Hawks goal could not hold it and the ball went through her hands and into the goal for Sawbo to be in front once again. The first half continued with both sides having attempts on goal but no real chances were taken. All this half ex England and Arsenal forward Angela Banks had been kept quiet by stalwart defending by Hannah Fraser and Nina Witteridge

After the interval the game continued at a high level with both sets of players trying to either get a bigger margin ahead or by getting an equaliser. Banks seemed to have used the half time break to get her thoughts into shape as she started to break the clamp that had been put on her and on 51 minutes unleashed a shot that Williams was able to save while diving to her right. With the Sawbow team having challenged every ball it was time to start getting some fresh legs on the park and Natalie Till replaced Joanne Gregory with some 30 minutes remaining. Some 5 minutes later it was the turn of Jackie Stott to be replaced by Ann Anstey who made an instant impact because of her ability to give extra mobility to the midfield. With some 20 minutes left to play Hannah Fraser who had worked tirelessly in the back line was replaced by Robyn McFayden to keep up the good work that had been done in keeping Banks quiet. With the last 10 minutes on the clock Sawbow were looking at another major coup but it was not to be as Banks suddenly showed her brilliance. A quick drop of the shoulder a yard of space and the ball hit the back of the net from 18 yards to level the scores. This goal was like a kick in the stomach to the Sawbow team as they had matched all that Whitehawk had to throw at them and it really did take the stuffing out of them. The Hawks went in front 3 minutes later as a shot from Banks hit the post and the rebound fell kindly to Kate Baker to side foot the ball home for Whitehawk to get their noses in front for the first time in the game. Cottenham travelled to Sawbridgeworth with just 10 players after two players phoned in ill on the morning of the match. Sawbo also had Laura Day and Kelly Mullender missing through illness and working commitments but was still able to field a full 11 plus have the luxury of a single substitute. This would be the third game in a row that the team had to be reshuffled on the morning of the game but Sawbo's depth of squad once again came to the rescue.

With just 10 players Cottenham came to defend and they were marshalled very well by the Cottenham player of the match Annette Stock. Sawbo were playing the better football but were unable to unlock the door for a final shot on goal. On 18 minutes Cottenham had shed their defensive third and managed to penetrate into the middle third only to see the move break down and the ball passed early back into their half. 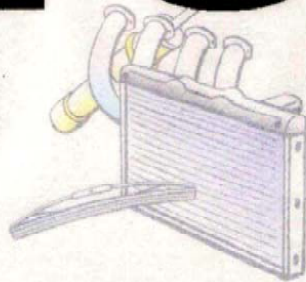

Following on from last weeks game the confidence in the team was growing and today against Old Island there was to be a better understanding as the team played its second league game of the season.

The game started briskly by both teams with the ball being played along the ground for forwards to run onto and create chances. After a while it was Sawbow who took the initiative when Claire Long received the ball and shot home the opener. This goal settled Sawbow and they grew in confidence and with this confidence the ball was being played all over the park to willing players. As the confidence grew so did the number of chances being created and Long was on hand to extend Sawbow's lead.
