The managers point of view

Firstly let me welcome the players officials and spectators of Huntingdon Town to Crofters for this afternoons Eastern Region Division One West game. We hope you enjoy your short stay with us and that you have a safe journey home afterwards.

We fell at the first hurdle of the League Cup last week to a scrappy goal. Overall our performance should have given us more but it was not to be. The new formation took time to settle and the weather was the major winner on the day. At the time of writing the pitch was still a little under water (Thursday) so we are hopeful that the game will go ahead today. The amount of water that dropped from the sky last week during a 45 minute spell was unbelievable but to both teams credit they continued to play, the game being abandoned after 85 minutes was the right decision.

Today we take on an emerging Huntingdon side that have stabilised over the past few weeks and will be much more of a test than our last meeting when they could only field 8 players and we came away with a 9-0 victory.

Our previous meeting this season

Huntingdon Town v Sawbridgeworth Town 0 - 9

Huntingdon who were relegated from the Premier division last season are finding life difficult in their new division as with new players and a different standard of football all having to be accomplished very quickly. In their first game against AFC Kempston Rovers they were defeated 9 - 2 so Sawbo felt they were in with a chance of 3 points if they continued where they left off last week against Spurs.

Sawbow were a goal up after just 5 minutes when Laura Day slotted the ball home from 10 yards. Seven minutes later the first of 2 goals by Judith Duffin who fired across the keeper and into the net and her second some 4 minutes later was slotted home inside the near post. Huntingdon were still battling well but on 36 minutes pressure from birthday girl Kelly Mullender and Carlye Stein forced an attempted back pass that bounced awkwardly and into the net for an own goal and Sawbow's forth on 36 minutes. Just before the break Carlye Stein shot home from just inside the box to continue her goal a game performance.

The second half began as the first had finished with Judith Duffin causing havoc down the flank with her pace and on 47 minutes she secured her hat trick with a low shot that beat the keeper just inside the post. After a series of missed chances by Natalie Till and Laura Day it seemed that the scoring would dry up but with chances still being made it was inevitable that another goal would come and Till scored on 65 minutes to make the score 7 - 0. As Huntingdon began to tire more and more space was being created on both flanks which gave Mullender and Duffin space to exploit the opposition defence but time and again the cross was not being met or was being driven high or wide of the target. As the last 5 minutes on the clock ticked around Day made it 8 - 0 and then with just 2 minutes to go Jackie Stott unleashed a left foot drive into the top corner. This win places Sawbridgeworth Town in second place in the league table albeit on goal difference but a nice place to be all the same.

This was an emphatic win by Sawbow against a dogged but deflated Huntingdon team. Sawbow would have liked a stronger opposition as they look forward to next weeks FA Cup 2nd Qualifying round game against Whitehawk who will be travelling from Brighton for the game. Sawbo will be playing a mid-week league game against Hoddesdon Owls at Hertford Town FC on Wednesday night with a 7.30pm kick off as the league tries to alleviate the need for fixture pile ups at the end of the season.

Sawbridgeworth Town v Godmanchester Rovers 0 - 1

As this was a cup game Sawbridgeworth altered their usual system of play to a more containing line up but the outcome was not what was expected. After just 5 minutes Debbie Williams in the Sawbo goal made a diving save at the feet of Godmanchester forward Sarah Mansfield and Rovers having much the better of this first period with the slope and wind in their favour were putting the Sawbo midfield and back line under pressure. On 22 minutes a free kick was awarded to Rovers about 22 yards out Mansfield strode up and fired the ball goal ward and on the very wet surface the ball skidded and bounced awkwardly and Williams could only get fingers to it as it spun past her and into the net for the opening goal. From this moment on the game took on a frantic motion as each side tried to get control and with the weather degrading as the game continued the game also took on a different attitude.

The second half saw the Sawbridgeworth side more determined and with the slope in their favour there were great periods of time spent in the Rovers half but the final shot on goal was not testing enough. With the weather deteriorating as the game continued vast swathes of water was now laying on the pitch and although the ball was still moving across the water it was becoming more and more difficult to pass or move the ball with accuracy. Overall Sawbridgeworth can count themselves unlucky not to have at least got the game level but in the end the winner was the weather. A torrential 40 minutes rain storm prevented what could have been a very entertaining encounter that both teams gave everything to play in. The game was abandoned after 85 minutes due to the pitch becoming unplayable because of the water on the pitch.



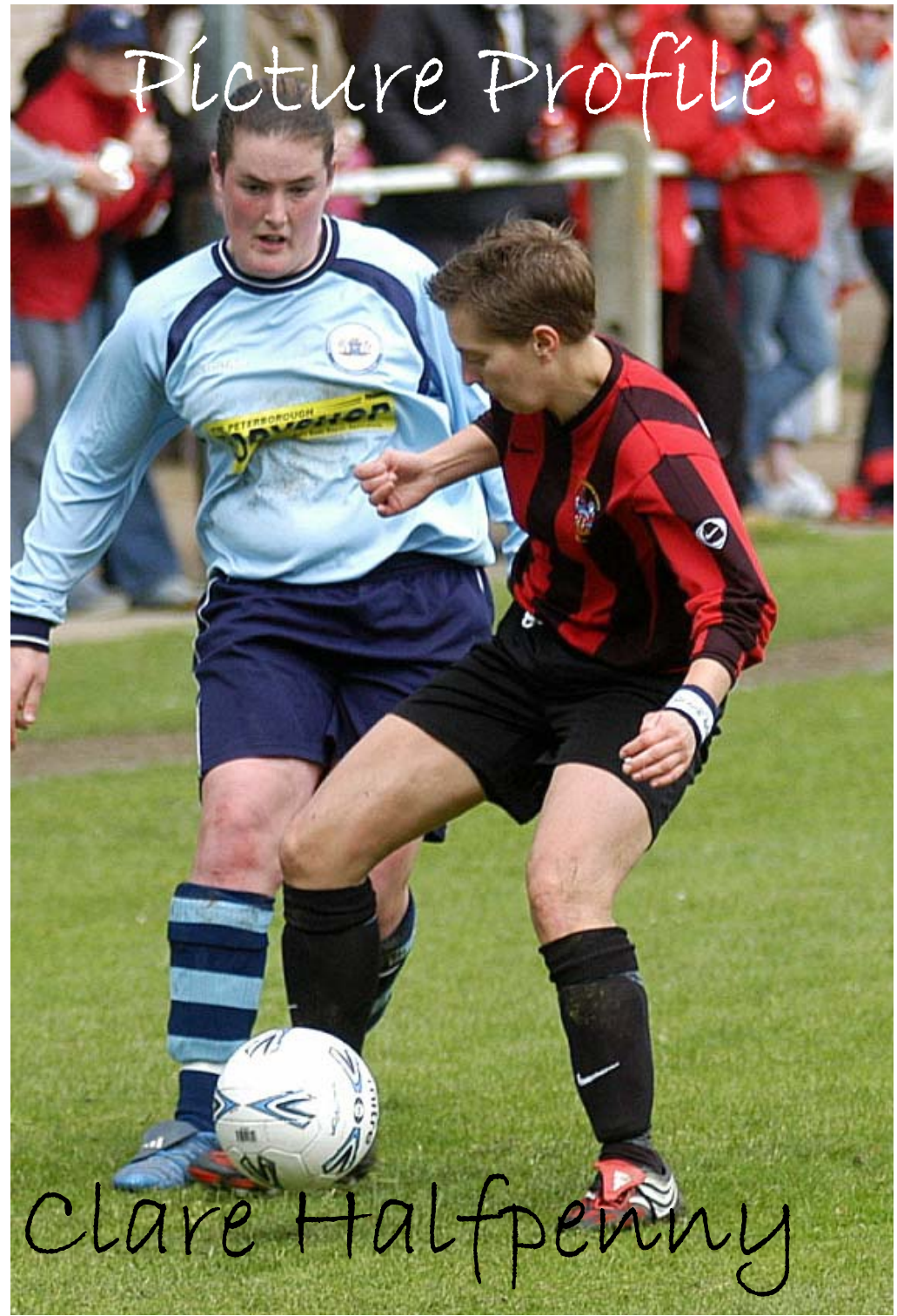
